Equipment

1. Hockey stick

2. Mouthguard

3. Shinpads

4. Astroturf trainers


5. Long socks

6. Left hand glove (optional, but would recommend if you value your knuckles)

The basics

- Played on a 91.4m x 55m astroturf.
- 11 players on the pitch, one of them is (hopefully) a goalkeeper.
- Maximum of 16 players (up to 5 subs (hopefully)), subs are "rolling".
 Rolling subs: players can swap at any time during the game.
- You score by getting the ball into the goal, you can only score from within "the D".
- Matches are split into 35min halves, you swap halves at half time.
- There are two umpires controlling either side of the pitch.

The pitch



General rules

- The ball cannot touch any part of your body (unless your hand, if it is on the stick).
 - Most of the time it is a foul because the ball has hit your **foot**.
- The ball can only touch the front of your stick (the flat bit).
- To tackle another player, you must cleanly get the ball, if you hit the opponent's stick this is called a **stick tackle** and it is a foul.
- When the ball goes off the sideline or baseline or a foul has been called by the umpire, the ball must be stopped, and all other players must be 5m from the player taking the ball.
- The ball must not go above knee height, otherwise it is considered dangerous.
- It is a non-contact sport, so no pushing.

Penalty Corner

 If there is a foul against the attacking team in the defending team's D, there is a short corner or penalty corner.

- 4 defenders + goalie line up in the goal behind the goal line.
- Attacking team have 1 player on the dash on the baseline with the ball, other players line up around the edge of the D.
- When the umpire calls "play" the player on the baseline can **inject** (pass) the ball out to a player on the edge of the D who then try to score a goal.
- The ball must not go in the air.

BUCS

- British University and College Sport

Mixed hockey

- In short corners the first shot on goal must be taken by a female player. After that anyone can score.
